



Row Hosts and Their Responsibilities

The work of the row host is to befriend those sitting in their rows, distribute response cards, and meet any needs that might arise during the meetings. The Outreach Leadership Team is to choose row hosts for the evangelistic seminar.

Responsibilities of the Row Hosts

- Row hosts are to come early — even if picking up an interest.
- They are to warmly greet the people that sit in their rows and make them feel welcome.
- They are to introduce themselves to those sitting in their rows and tell them they are helping with the seminar, and if they need anything to let them know.
- When a decision card is passed out, they are to fill it out and go forward if someone in their rows responds to a call.
- If a guest asks a question on a topic that the evangelist has not yet covered, the row host is to affirm the guest by saying, “That’s a good question,” then let them know that there is a presentation coming up that will deal with that subject and encourage the guest to keep coming.
- They are to provide additional information on the subject that has been presented if it is not clear to the guest.
- They are to introduce those sitting in their rows to the evangelist.
- If there is a serious problem or question, tell the evangelist — or ask if the guest would like to talk to the speaker and help make the arrangements.
