### **A. Getting Started**

- Play the following sections on the Revival Module Companion DVD, Part One:
  - Module Summary and Introduction
  - Goals for Revival
  - Overview of Revival Month

#### **TASKS**

- ✓ Discuss your church's overall spirituality and how it could benefit from the revival.
- ✓ Write down three to five realistic goals for your church's revival.
- ✓ Develop a proposal for the attainment of your church's revival goals.

### **B. Resources for the Revival Month**

- Play the section "Promotional Resources Available for Downloading" found on the Revival Module Companion DVD, Part One.

#### **TASKS**

- ✓ Assign responsibilities to ensure that the necessary resources are available when needed. Remember that all of the revival resources can be downloaded from the Empowered Church website at [www.empoweredchurch.org](http://www.empoweredchurch.org).
- ✓ Discuss ways in which each church department can promote the Revival Month.
- ✓ Make a list of the various promotional strategies and the people responsible for their implementation.
- ✓ Write down any additional events planned for the Revival Month (revival weekend, guest speakers, agape feast, etc.) and those responsible for each event.

### **C. Planning the Revival Month**

- Play the section "Planning the Revival" found on the Revival Module Companion DVD, Part One.

## TASKS

- ✓ Consider each of the following steps that are included in the implementation of the Revival Month, and list when each should be completed and who will be responsible for each one:

- Letter to be sent by the pastor to church members. The letter should be sent this month.
- Preach revival sermons.
- Emphasis on prayer and personal devotions in Sabbath school.
- Emphasis on prayer and personal devotions at prayer meetings.
- Encourage the church members to utilize bulletin insert packets.
- Utilize the announcement time to encourage personal devotions.
- Utilize the power of personal testimony.
- Plan a meeting of departmental leaders and the Outreach Leadership Team one week before the start of the Revival Month.

### D. Wrapping It Up

- Play the selection *"Conclusion"* found on the Revival Module Companion DVD, Part One.

#### TASKS:

- ✓ Refer to the section "Questions and Answers" in the program set-up module to answer any questions that were written down while viewing the various sections of the companion DVD.

**Remember to close your meeting with special prayer, asking God to bless your church's revival in a very special way!**

### *Summary of Responsibilities*

|                                       |   |   |
|---------------------------------------|---|---|
| Pastor                                | ☞ | Send letter to members announcing revival two or three weeks in advance.  |
| Outreach Leadership Team              | ☞ | Plan to meet with church leaders and department directors one week before the revival begins to follow up on assigned responsibilities. |
| Church leaders and dept. heads        | ☞ | Meet with their respective staffs to determine how they will implement the revival theme.   |
| Pastors or elders                     | ☞ | Determine sermons and prayer meeting topics that will emphasize the devotional life.  |
| Church secretary or designated person | ☞ | Download from the Empowered Church website the resources that will be used during the Revival Month.                                    |
